Date: Saturday, February 3rd, 2018

Time: 7:30 am (shelter open by 6 am; course briefing at 7:15 a.m.) (If you typically take more than 7½ hours to complete a 50K, you should consider starting early.)

Place: D.J. Mackie Group Picnic Area – South Unit of the Kettle Moraine State Forest (on Hwy ZZ, between Hwy 67 and Hwy G) ([Google Map Link HERE](#)). **Parking is limited, so please car pool if possible.** Once the lot is full, you may park along the edges of the entrance drive. Parking is also allowed along highway ZZ, but all wheels of your vehicle must be fully off of the pavement. Additional parking lots are located about ½ mile east and west along highway ZZ.

NOTE: A Wisconsin State Park sticker is required for parking, and is not included in the entry fee. Stickers will be for sale at registration if needed; please bring exact change or check payable to WI DNR:

Description: Primitive trail run (usually on the snowmobile trails in the area), with multiple loops or out-and-back segments; course layout will be determined by trail and weather conditions. **The course map linked above was used last year, but is subject to change!** Participants should be experienced and accustomed to winter trail running, properly dressed and prepared. If you DNF, please notify the aid station and finish line personnel.

Aid Station: One manned aid station with a variety of food and fluids (an unmanned AS may be added if needed) so that aid is available at 4-7 mile intervals. We will have a spot at the manned AS for drop bags if you want to use one.

Dogs: Dogs are not allowed at group picnic areas, per DNR regulations; please make other arrangements for your pets.

Perks: Heated shelter at start and finish, with food and beverage for all entrants after the race (bring a treat to share if you want!).

Awards: First male and female finisher only.

Entry Fee: **\$10** (check payable to BLS; please mail by January 29th)
\$15 (day of race; please bring exact change or check payable to BLS)
